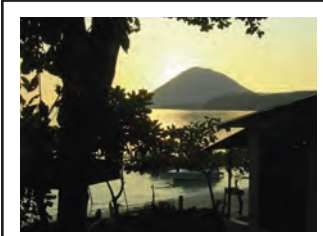


## About North Sulawesi

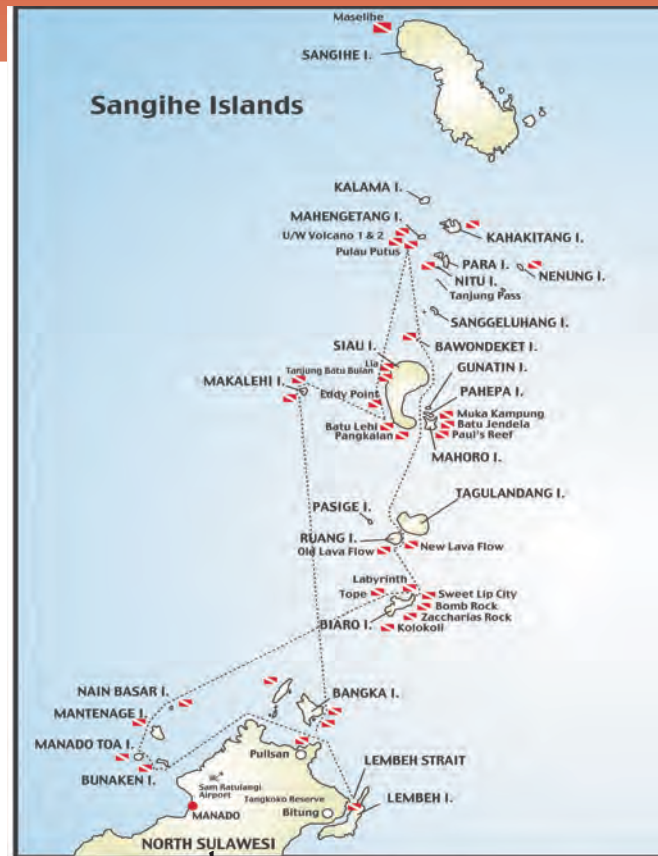

## Getting There:

No matter where in the world our divers come from, getting to North Sulawesi is easy. The most direct way to reach Manado's Sam Ratulangi International Airport (city code MDC) is via Singapore. Singapore Airlines offers service from most European, North America and Asian cities. Singapore to Manado is on Silk Air, Singapore Air's regional carrier. Flight time from Singapore to Manado is 3 hours and 20 minutes and many of the overnight flights from Europe and North America arrive early enough in Singapore to connect with the flight to Manado, with just a short transit. 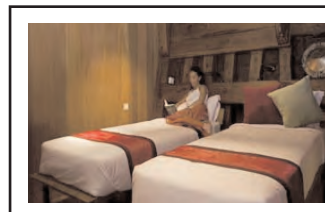


### The Diving...

Paradise Dancer utilizes her size and range to provide a 320-nautical mile journey through the waters surrounding North Sulawesi northward to the Sangihe Islands and back down to Bunaken National Marine Park before completing the voyage by visiting Lembeh Strait. The diving ranges from magnificent coral gardens at Bunaken Marine Park and Bangka Strait to walls, schools of fishes and underwater volcanoes at the Sangihe Islands to the unusual and rarely seen critters of Lembeh Strait. The remote location of the Sangihe Islands has kept marine life diverse and prolific and the pristine waters are consistently clear blue with visibility on average of 100 to 150 feet. This area is truly a paradise for divers with a bit of experience and Paradise Dancer is the perfect vessel to take you there.

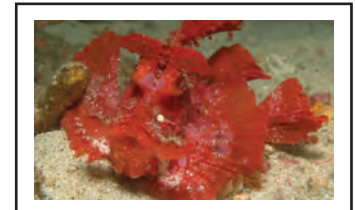


### Onboard Paradise Dancer



Based in North Sulawesi, Indonesia, April through September, the Paradise Dancer will explore the water in and around North Sulawesi. Paradise Dancer is a traditionally-crafted, three-masted wooden motor sailor, stretching 188 feet long, 39 feet wide and accommodating 18 adventurous divers. All of the state rooms will be larger than

traditional liveaboard state rooms, at 180 square feet each plus there is a 470 square foot "Master and Commander Suite"! Following the standards of the Dancer Fleet®, the Paradise Dancer replicates Peter Hughes Diving® service, amenities and the highest standards of safety in the industry.



### Tour Some More...

Extend your stay in North Sulawesi and explore the natural wonders of the area.
